The Post-Crescent “Stock the Shelves” Program raises \$275,000!

The Post-Crescent’s 14th annual “Stock the Shelves” Do It! Community Campaign exceeded its \$250,000 goal by \$25,000. Nineteen food pantries in the newspaper’s circulation area benefited from this year’s program.

We were able to reach our unprecedented goal because of the matching grants from our corporate partners. The J. J. Keller Foundation matched total contributions up to \$50,000, local credit unions within the Fox Cities Chapter of Credit Unions and Premier Financial Credit Union matched total contributions up to \$35,000 and Express Convenience Centers donated a nickel for every gallon of gas purchased, up to \$50,000.

Express Convenience Centers and participating Credit Unions also collected thousands of non-perishable food items for local pantries.

Participating credit unions include Fox Communities Credit Union, Capital Credit Union, Badger Globe Credit Union, Evergreen Credit Union, Community First Credit Union, Lakeview Credit Union, Best Advantage Credit Union, Unison Credit Union, Members United Credit Union, Menasha Employees Credit Union, Premier Financial Credit Union, Menasha Corporation Employees Credit Union, CONE Credit Union, Envision Credit Union, Labor Credit Union, St. Elizabeth Employees Credit Union, KimCentral Credit Union, Prospera Credit Union and the Fox Cities Chapter of Credit Unions.
