Fox Communities Credit Union Breaks Ground On New Office In Black Creek

Fox Communities Credit Union will hold a groundbreaking ceremony for its new location in Black Creek on Wednesday, July 23rd at 5:00. This office will be located at 502 South Main Street. They will be moving from their current location on N4512 County Road A, Black Creek. It will be a full service branch with two drive-up lanes and a drive-up ATM.

Tara Banker, Branch Manager at the Black Creek/Center Valley location mentions, “We are looking forward to going into Black Creek. Our hours will expand to open the drive up at 7:00 am Monday through Friday and to be open until 6:00 pm on both Thursday and Friday evenings. These new hours will match those at our offices in the Appleton area. This, coupled with additional services and an ATM, will better meet the needs of the current and future members in the Black Creek community.”

According to President Greg Hilbert, “We are excited about this new location. It will operate as a full service branch which includes mortgage and consumer lending. By moving into Black Creek, we feel that this will be a convenient location for both our existing members and potential new members. The anticipated opening date is planned for November 2008. As we continue to grow, we are grateful to our members and staff who have made this possible.”

Membership, at Fox Communities Credit Union, is open to anyone who lives or works in Brown, Calumet, Kewaunee, Manitowoc, Oconto, Outagamie, Shawano, Waupaca or Winnebago counties.
