Rebuilding Together will be working on a project in the Clintonville area on Saturday, Sept. 27, 2008.

Rebuilding Together (Fox Valley) is a non-profit volunteer organization that “preserves and revitalizes homes and communities, assuring that low income homeowners, specifically senior and those with disabilities can continue to live in warmth, safety and independence.” They are also part of the national Rebuilding Together organization.

Some of the project day home repairs could include: making bathrooms accessible, fixing the lighting, ceilings or walls, wheelchair accessible entrances, painting, furnace or plumbing repair, and much more.

This local project is being sponsored by Fox Communities Credit Union, Torborg’s Lumber and the Clintonville Rotary club. Additional sponsorships are also available.

If you are a homeowner that is in need of help to fix up your house, please fill out an application. Applications are available at the Clintonville Public Library and at Fox Communities Credit Union. You can also make a referral if you know a homeowner that fits the criteria.

Once the applications are received, members of the House Selection Team of Rebuilding Together will conduct an inspection and review areas of concern. The entire home is assessed for other potential safety or accessibility issues. They then determine which home(s) will be chosen based on selection criteria and available financial and volunteer resources.
